COMPLETION CARDS (BLUE CARDS)

## Materials to include in an Opioid Overdose responder kit:

- Certificate of Completion Cards (**example below**)
- Naloxone instructions (i.e., nasal spray or intramuscular formulations)
- Naloxone Co-payment Assistance Program (N-CAP)

## Instructions for Ordering Blue Cards

Include in email:

- Title and publication # of material(s) 3.5" x 2"(pub # 9808) OR 3" x 4"(pub # 9819).
- Quantity (do not exceed 500)
- Requester's name, agency and mailing address (P.O. Box not accepted)

**IMPORTANT:** Allow 2 weeks for the delivery of your requested material's. The Distribution Center does not confirm your order with an email confirmation.

## 'BLUE' Certificate of Completion cards

After the completion of an Opioid Overdose training trained responders are given a 2-sided *certificate of completion* confirming they completed the training.
